PUBLIC HEARING TO EXCEED THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE (RNR) and to APPROVE THE 2025 BUDGET:

MOTION: Marcia Bailey moved to adopt Resolution No. 2024-1 authorizing a levy of property taxes in support of the FY 2025 budget that requires a property tax rate exceeding the revenue neutral rate of 9.451 mills for Johnson County Consolidated Fire District No. 2. MOTION: Tim Janssen moved to adopt Resolution No. 2024-2 approving the FY 2025 budget for Johnson County Consolidated Fire District No. 2 as proposed with a maximum budget of \$21,993,033 for CFD2 FY2025, which includes all CFD2 cash assets, debt service, and the operational budget, and is projected to hold the Mill Levy at 10.007 for 2025. John Hunkeler seconded the motion.
