



Thank you for your interest in Fire Safety Month. CFD2 is proud to serve our community and would welcome the opportunity to present a fire safety program to the children at your school. We would like to provide some guidelines to ensure that everyone can enjoy and benefit from this presentation.

The program consists of two parts. The first segment will include a fire safety talk covering essential topics such as smoke detectors, appropriate responses during emergencies, whom to contact in case of an emergency, safety tips, and drills for children to practice at home with their parents. Additionally, there will be a demonstration of a firefighter donning their gear and using their self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA).

The second segment will feature a "show and tell" where children will have the chance to go outside to observe the equipment on a fire truck, along with a brief explanation of its uses, weather permitting.

Please note that the fire personnel delivering this presentation will be on-duty. Therefore, if an emergency call arises, the crew will need to respond immediately. To ensure the safety of all participants, a teacher or responsible adult must remain with the children at all times. This is crucial for ensuring that everyone is clear of the fire apparatus before it departs. If time permits, the fire crew will return to complete the presentation after attending to any emergency calls.

To minimize interruptions and ensure that the fire crews return to their station in a timely manner, we have established a schedule designed for efficient presentation delivery.

When addressing multiple grade levels, we request that each grade be grouped together in a spacious area, such as a lunchroom or gymnasium. This arrangement allows all students in a particular grade—such as first grade—to receive the talk simultaneously, rather than having the fire crew repeat the presentation for smaller groups. This portion of the presentation is expected to last approximately 15 minutes.

While the indoor talk is in progress, individual classes from other grades can participate in the outdoor "show and tell" segment to explore the fire truck. If resources allow, the crews may bring multiple trucks, enabling two classes to engage at once. This segment should last about 10 minutes.
